## **Emergency Child Care**

### **Grades K-5**

**Clark Memorial YMCA will be hosting an Emergency Child Care site, beginning Monday, 3/23. This program is to support essential workers and vulnerable families that have no other option for childcare services.**

**Examples of essential workers and vulnerable families include but are not limited to: health care workers (including essential support functions), essential state and human service workers, COVID-19 health workers, grocery store employees, emergency response personnel, law enforcement, transportation and infrastructure workers, sanitation workers, DCF involved families, and families living in shelters.**

**Emergency Child Care will be available Monday – Friday from 6:30 AM – 6:00 PM. This is a drop-in program, with no preregistration required. However, please leave a little time while dropping off on first day to fill out a brief information form. If your child will be in the program during lunch hours, please be sure to pack a lunch for your child. The program will be held at the Y Youth Center (enter Y parking lot from Summer St, follow driveway to end; Youth Center last building on right.)**
